PIDE, Xinjiang varsity sign MoU to boost research, innovation

ÜRÜMQI: The Pakistan Institute of Development Economics (PIDE) and Xinjiang University held a symposium and signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in Ürümqi, China, to strengthen academic and research collaboration. The event marks an important milestone in fostering institutional cooperation, research partnerships, and people-to-people linkages between Pakistan and China under the framework of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) and the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), a news release said on Tuesday. The symposium was chaired by Dr. Liu Zhengjiang, Vice President of Xinjiang University, who also served as the Master of Ceremony. The session began with the introduction of attendees, followed by the screening of a promotional video highlighting Xinjiang University's academic achievements and international outreach. A group photograph marked the conclusion of the event, capturing the spirit of friendship and cooperation between the two academic communities.
