

Cleaning Campaign at Shadra Valley under Green Youth Movement

Under the Green Youth Movement, cleaning campaign was held at Shadra Valley Islamabad on 09th March 2023. Students from both schools of PIDE participated in this activity. Dr. Ehsan ul Haq Satii & Khurram Ellahi led the students for said activity.

Waste management is a rising concern in Pakistan. An inefficient waste management system with limited capacity and the irresponsible behavior of the citizens are equally at fault. One can't even walk around a major city like Islamabad without seeing plastic littered all around them. To counter this problem, Green Youth Movement plays a vital role by collaborating with different institutions and student bodies to encourage environmentally conscious behavior among the youth. Investing into the future, the foundation of the green movement, is perfectly captured by the Cleaning Campaign held in Shahdara Valley.

Shahdara Valley is a popular tourist spot in the northeastern hills of Islamabad. Stationed only a short drive away from Quaid Azam University, it is loved by students and locals alike. Therefore, like most tourist destinations, Shahdara Valley is polluted by plastic waste left behind by tourists. Moreover, the existence of the stream makes Shahdara Valley an important location as waste travels downstream and pollutes water bodies around the city. Therefore, Shahdara Valley was prioritized for the cleaning campaign. To encourage the participation of the students, to have a friendly competition, participants were divided into two teams who were competing to collect the most garbage.
