

#### Theological Shades of Global Sociology


Differences in sociological phenomena very often arising from ideological differences

The oldest and the strongest of the ideological differences have always been associated with the theological phenomena


Muslims who account for one fifth of the humanity are particularly going through various kinds of pressures of the rising tide of globalization




