### Households Study on Out-Of-Pocket (OOP) Health Expenditure in Pakistan

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### Background

- Health Expenditure to GDP Ratio
- Public has no choice but to seek health care from own Pocket, which dominant source of finance
- In Pakistan OOP Expenditure is two third of total expenditure
- Pakistan annual per capita income is \$1,368 but health expenditure is \$35

### Background

- Share of OOP health expenditure out of the total household income
- National Health Accounts
- Meeting public demand of healthcare is a great challenge for governments
- Unmet demand, people may opt for less costly healthcare like traditional or sub optimal care, or even forgo healthcare

### Objectives

- Estimate nationally representativeOOP health expenditures for Pakistan
- Provide OOP health expenditures over time and across regions in Pakistan
- Analyze OOP health expenditures with respect to vulnerable groups in Pakistan

#### Data

- We pooled six nationally representative HIESs (1998-99, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11)
- Surveys cover all four provinces
- Each survey is represented by around 15,000 households
- Total sample is 91,404 households
- OOP health expenditure is reported in the consumption module

Data Cont..

- In first three surveys, the health expenditure categories
  - Purchase of medicines, equipment supplies etc
  - Medical fees paid to doctors, Hakeem (traditional healer) etc. outside hospital including medicines
  - Hospitalization including doctors' fees, laboratory tests, X-ray charges etc
  - Dental/Optical care and all other expenses on healthcare not classified elsewhere.
- In last three survey, the later three categories were lumped into one

### Methodology

- Totaled all health expenditures into one category
- Due to aggregation, we have only 0.25% missing values
- First step: Estimation of OOP by applying survey weights
- Second Step: Estimated OOP is raised to actual population

### Methodology

- Estimated average and per capita OOP over the time (1998-99 to 2010-11) across time, regions and provinces
- Calculated poverty line (\$1.25) at each HH level and then calculated % of HH above and below the line





#### Discussion

- HHs of KPK spend highest for OOP health expenditure
- This may due to higher literacy rate and income
- Urban HHs spent less on health as compared to rural
- This shows that in rural areas lack of health facilities pushed the people to spend more. The lack of health facilities and improper medical facilities may be a factor for high disease prevalence rates and health problems.

#### Discussion

- Total and per capita OOP by private HHs and Govt are increasing (indicating realization health importance)
- Contrary, Govt's health expenditure to GDP ratio is less than one percent (volatile & deceasing)
- OOP share, out of HHs is decreasing
- More health awareness is required for private households and government.

#### Discussion

- We could not find evidence for higher rural share within country but cross country results show that on average in low incomes countries OOP share is higher than richer countries
- Health needs often push households into selling their assets or borrow cash
- Catastrophic health expenditures can push vulnerable groups to poverty

#### Conclusion

- Study analyzed OOP health expenditure patterns of Pakistan historically, across provinces, rural and urban areas and between below & above poverty line
- Absolute amount of OOP and government is increasing
- Spending shares out of income are declining, which should be major policy concern

#### Conclusion

- The more rural health expenditure should also be policy dimension as most rural household already living under the absolute poverty and such expenditures will push them into further poverty trap.
- The disparity among the provinces is also another policy attention.
- Findings suggest a holistic health policy formulation in Pakistan.
