

All we need is to send an input via GSM SIM in the form of a SMS. The system will read that SMS and will convey the input to the system and it will switch on or switch off the appliance as per direction given to the system by android application.

give a solution to the world for more output, using less resources.


Departmental Achivements


sectors. Gulf existing between the academia and industry was also shared with the students. Seminar also touched on how effectively we can prepare our CV and Resume for particular job market.


